Enrich cultural experience. The DeSoto County Courthouse was constructed in 1913. The building is ornate with brick facing and large ornate windows. Restoration of broken and missing brick, replacing rusting window shelves and lintels, repairing concrete cracks and grout, and sealing the building will restore the glory of the building and more importantly, provide a safe and sealed facility for court purposes. Construction repair will not change the historical appearance of the building. Moisture content reduction inside facility and visual physical repairs on exterior.
