12. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds requested will provide anywhere from 50-75 units of attainable housing for those experiencing poverty and homelessness in Osceola County. Having a safe place to call home is the first step to achieving self-determined stability, as it paves the way for individuals to move from short-term issue solving to long-term planning and goal setting in various aspects of their lives.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Hope Partnership will build new units or convert a motel into affordable housing units while providing wrap around services through the program entities. Hope Works can provide employment assistance, training and referrals. Hope Center can provide case management and peer support groups. Hope Cares can provide emergency assistance such as supplemental food.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This appropriation project will provide 50-75 units to residents who are currently living in unstable housing such as hotels/motels or who are experiencing literal homelessness.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population will be those experiencing homelessness and poverty in Osceola County. Depending on the size of the property, Hope Partnership could serve up to 150 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefits of this project include improved physical and mental health and enhancing individuals economic self-sufficiency. Hope Partnership programs currently use a modified Arizona Self Sufficiency matrix to track changes in sufficiency over a series of domains including health and income. Additionally, with a new program being launched around mental health and peer support groups, progress in those programs will be tracked using industry standard and validated measurements to be determined by the program manager and counselor when hired.



f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Suggested penalties include returning funds if the metrics are not met.
