At this vibrant facility, the community will unite to prepare each and every student for life.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Funds will be used to design and renovate a multi-purpose facility that will serve as a centralized HUB to provide direct educational resources, services, and programming for students, teachers, families/caregivers, and community partners. As facility is under construction, services will be provided in temporary space located in Sarasota Rosemary District.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Choice Navigators help students find the right K-12 school.

Student Success Coaches and mentors help students plan for life after high school.

Resiliency Coaches help at-risk students graduate from high school and strengthen hard/soft life skills.

PLANit Sarasota convenes community partners to reach the 60% goal set by Sail to 60.

Scholarships create opportunities for postsecondary education.

Teacher support resources innovate education.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

K-12 students, families, caregivers; at-risk youth; postsecondary students; adult volunteers, community partners, teachers.

This facility will be available to more than 44,000 students and their families.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit is to improve quality of education and outcomes for students.

Specific measures include:

Establish baseline of K – 12 students/families consulting with Choice Navigators.

Increase # of high school graduates who develop postsecondary plans.

Increase % of working-age adults who hold a high-quality certificate, degree or diploma.

Increase # of families/caregivers who have awareness of FLDOE Student Resiliency Toolkit.

Increase # of teachers participating in professional learning.

The methodology of measurement will include: Sign-in data. Student/family and teacher surveys. Graduation data. US Census data. Talent Strong Florida (FCAN) data. Evidence of planning for life beyond high school, including: Meetings with Student Success Coaches. FAFSA completions. College applications. Work-based learning, internships, job offers. Scholarship searches and applications. Workshop attendance.
