a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Goal is protection of life, health and safety of citizenry and business community from flooding with improved stormwater management. Reduced flooding with installation of appropriate stormwater infrastructure.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will be used to seek contractual construction for services for project management, engineering during construction and construction for stormwater infrastructure as designed through the City's procurement procedures and policies.



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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services to citizens will be protection of public from dangerous flooding and unsafe conditions, reduction of accidents, protection of property with repair/replacement of old failing stormwater infrastructure. Reduction of total maximum daily loads (TMDL), pollutants, phosphorus and nitrogen by replacing/repairing/upgrading with improved piping, baffle boxes, water quality/ guantity components.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population is the City of Belle Glade, which is a financially disadvantaged municipality (ch. 62-552, F.A.C.) that is located in a Rural Area of Economic Concern/Rural Area of Opportunity (s. 288.0656, Florida Statutes). The number of individuals expected to be served include the visitors, residents and businesses of the City of Belle Glade, which exceeds 17,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected outcome is completion of the stormwater conveyance improvements, reduction in loss of use of roadways, safety improved; property damage decreased, less flooding, safer transportation, improved stormwater infrastructure protects the general public and environment with installation of water quality/quantity components. Certification of project.
