The renovated and expanded facility will include exhibits and services to disseminate historical information related to the Bay of Pigs invasion and it's heroes to local visitors, also domestic and foreign tourists visiting the museum.

Offer seminars and conferences to students and other personnel and local organizations.

The museum receives more than 5,000 visitors/year and it is expected that this amount could increase as much as two-fold. The museum ranks #14 by Trip Advisor out of 80 museums in the Miami/Dade area.

It is expected that with the upgrading and expansion of the museum, the number of visitors will increase, therefore offering a valuable attraction to the thousands of tourists visiting the Miami/Dade area. The successful outcome will be measured by the increased number of visitors to the museum and increased number of programming.
