14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of this request is to increase the labor pool of trained, skilled workers in the Department of Labors career clusters of Health Science and Transportation. Funds will be utilized to provide scholarships for adult students enrolling in commercial vehicle driving (CVD) and medical programs; part-time instructors to support increased enrollment; and to engage in a feasibility study related to the implementation of an agriculture based cross curricular program.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will be used to provide career development and workforce education directly to citizens. Targeted areas of training are commercial vehicle driving and health sciences.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The target population for this project is the residents of the Glades Region of Palm Beach County (Belle Glade, South Bay, Pahokee, and Canal Point) that are 18 years or older and are seeking to secure a Commercial Drivers License or a medical science credential such as home health aide, phlebotomist, EKG aide, and or medical assistant to broaden their employment options.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population for this project is the residents of the Glades Region of Palm Beach County (Belle Glade, South Bay, Pahokee, and Canal Point) that are 18 years or older and are seeking to secure a Commercial Drivers License or a medical science credential such as home health aide, phlebotomist, EKG aide, and or medical assistant to broaden their employment options.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Outcome - Short Term: 70% or greater of the scholarship recipients will be employed in-field within 6 months of program completion

Benefit - Long Term: Decreased employment rate of Glades residents which is measured every 5 years Methodology - Short Term: Recording of employment status upon program entry, completion, and 6 months after completion followed by data comparison to determine impact of participating in the program

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Unemployment in the Glades area is typically four to five times higher than the other portions of Palm Beach County. The latest five-year estimates for 2016 – 2020 place South Bay with the lowest unemployment rate among the three communities at 10.7%, followed by Belle Glade at 13.3%, and Pahokee has the highest unemployment rate at 23.8%. Failure to meet the performance measures could result in continued high unemployment rates due to lack of a trained, skilled labor pool.
