a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The City conducted a structural assessment of the pier, which resulted in recommendations for a new substructure, restoration of spalled concrete piles, replacement of beams, wood decking, new wood railings, restoration of the pavilion, replacements of the lighting system and lightning protection, and new furnishings. The listed repairs would allow the pier to be 100% operational.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The activities to be carried out with this funding request consist of building a new substructure, restoration of spalled concrete piles, replacement of beams, wood decking, new wood railings, restoration of the pavilion, replacements of the lighting system and lightning protection, and new furnishings.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Direct services will include the restoration and improvement to the existing pier, which allow continued access to anglers, sightseers, and the many programs and events that take place on the pier throughout the year.
