14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Funding would provide for construction of a new SWAT training tower. A new tower will replace the existing wooden tower that was built by hand more than 30 years ago and has reached the end of its useful life. The new tower will allow the SWAT Team, and other local, state and federal first responders, to experience realistic training scenarios and techniques in rope rescue and maneuvers, train to act from elevated positions and handle issues in stairwells, all while increasing proficiency in their craft.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Training of active law enforcement personnel to address high risk and specialized tactical situations. Additionally, surrounding local, state and federal partners will utilize the tower for training. Activities will include repelling and tactical entries from elevated platforms.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

A more professional and highly trained first responder that can better address active assailant situations.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Primarily local, state and federal tactical teams as well as regular sworn first responders that may need additional advanced or specialized training in elevated search and rescue. 100 to 200 annually will be served by this tower.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Through regular training of these advanced tactics members will become more proficient and gain confidence in their abilities. Lessons plans, hands on learning and evaluations of skills taught.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Funding will be withheld by the State of Florida for the City of Lakeland.
