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The Polk County Jail Facilities are approximately 650,000 square foot in total building space that houses multiple classifications of inmates. Replacing the security equipment will increase the staff and inmates safety in these facilities. Innovations in security offers better efficiencies in monitoring and controlling security while adapting to increasing inmate population. Replacing the aging HVAC chiller will allow better dependability and efficiency to the cooling system while also increasing comfort control in the housing areas which will allow the Jail staff to perform their duties in a more calming environment.

Polk County Facilities Management Division will provide project management services and budget oversight through out the project from the beginning until project closeout.
