14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Access to reliable technology is a basic need and many in our community are left behind without the same opportunities as others. We will bridge the digital divide with a mobile computer bus that will foster greater digital equity and inclusion throughout our community. The following strategies will promote digital equity and inclusion: access, devices, and computer skills.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The mobile computer bus will allow citizens to increase their computer literacy, access free tax preparation services, access telehealth services, and access banking services. The mobile computer bus will also provide skills-based training with a focus on STEM to youth.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Financial digital education for adults and seniors, workshops that expose youth to STEM related-career paths, learning workshops for individuals to strengthen their digital skills to seek and secure employment using an online accredited curriculum, free tax preparation and banking services, and provide easier access to 211 and to immediate resources with community partners.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Once the retrofitting is completed, we expect to serve 400 to 800 underserved individuals, in year one. As this will be an ongoing program of Heart of Florida United Way, the number served will more than double in the subsequent year.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Heart of Florida United Way intends to retrofit a bus that will mobilize services for ALICE (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed) households related to health, financial stability, and education for low-income communities in the counties of Orange, Osceola and Seminole. HFUW will use case records and pre-/post-testing to track the number of locations and clients served by the mobile computer bus, increased knowledge of STEM-related fields and career opportunities, he number of program completers who receive technical certifications, and the number of program participants that receive a refurbished laptop computer.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Heart of Florida United Way will create and implement an action plan describing the steps we will take that will ensure HFUW meets deliverables and performance measures.
