14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

These funds will be used to hire two attorneys and a paralegal to provide legal counsel, services and representation to low-income homeowners who reside in a condominium or HOA and are facing the risk of foreclosure.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Through this project we will conduct outreach to identify homeowners in need of free legal representation and provide them with either legal counsel, help with drafting and submitting pro se pleadings and motions, or full legal representation. Coast to Coast Legal Aid staff will provide outreach to vulnerable older adults by holding events and community education at local senior living communities and other community partner events.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Legal counsel and advice, legal services and assistance with drafting pro se motions and pleadings and legal representation.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population for this project is low-income households that reside in a condominium or HOA community and are unjustly having their properties foreclosed. We will also mainly focus on elderly members of the community who are being targeted and are becoming victims of wrongdoing by condo/homeowners associations. We expect to serve between 100-200 clients during the first year of this project.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will provide legal representation to members of our community who are currently having their properties foreclosed on and cannot afford legal representation. Through our project and by providing vigorous legal representation to

those in need we will be able to save the homes of many homeowners who are currently having their properties foreclosed on

unjustly and thus keep vulnerable members of our community in their homes. This will be achieved by marketing efforts and

outreach to inform the community about our project and the free legal services that we offer to homeowners.
