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#### a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The "Ocean Heroes" program provides professional development and customized resources for communities for workforce development in the "Blue Economy" while inspiring these Ocean Ambassadors to become our "Leaders of Tomorrow". A key goal for the program is to bring public attention to critically important environmental issues, while engaging, educating, and inspiring communities to help protect and ensure the sustained well-being of marine animals and their respective habitats.

#### b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

State-of-the-Art technology, computer sciences, coding to support citizen science, discovery and advocacy. Through the integration of new database technologies data sets of fish species and respective population studies are helping to develop practical ways to manage and protect them. This helps to provide a unique insight among our communities on how technology and science play a critical role in the advancement of research and conservation. Ocean Heroes citizen science initiatives are creating ways for communities and families to engage in conservations efforts, while also providing insights on career opportunities within the Blue Economy.

#### c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Celebration of the Sea has successfully aggregated a consortium of partners from non-profits, research organizations, educational institutions, recreation companies and retailers to champion a common mission and message to protect our oceans by advocating for the next leaders of the blue economy. Communities and families can engage in our citizen science programs within their local communities to continue their enrichment and participation in ocean conservation.

#### d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Celebration of the Sea's Ocean Heroes Program targets the next generation of leaders for the blue economy – K thru 12th grade. The Foundation continues to offer and provide career pathway opportunities to youth in college and trade school, as well as job placement opportunities through the foundation supporters and partnerships.

### e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

As part of the Ocean Heroes Program, Celebration of the Sea Foundation works closely with schools and educators to ensure that the curriculum provided is meeting the needs of their students and classrooms. Each of the enrolled educators will have semi-annual check ins with program staff of Ocean Heroes to learn what is working and what needs adjustment. Additionally, check ins also allow for our team to observe engagement and education advancement – both quantitative and qualitatively. Celebration of the Sea tracks and measures the internship enrollment, and outcomes of who within the programs go on to pursue careers in the blue economy.

### f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

If Celebration of the Sea Foundation does not meet the deliverables set forth in the agreement, no additional funding will be awarded until all performance measures are fulfilled. Additionally, if an extension is required; no additional funding will be sought for a period of time equal to twice the extension duration.
