### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The project scope proposes additional research space for multiple engineering programs. Enrollment has grown in Electrical, Computer and Mechanical Engineering; Computer Science; Information Technology; and Mathematics and Statistics programs. Research space for these programs has not. Currently space is leased in multiple facilities off campus, which increases university costs and provides barriers to learning for students.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Construction of a new Science and Engineering Research Wing building addition is proposed for UWF Building 04. The building addition will provide for expanded research space for multiple programs including: Cybersecurity, Power, Unmanned Systems, Material Science, Robotics, Intelligent Systems, Computing, and Analytics.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Campus Improvement: A new mechanical engineering program began at UWF in the 2016 fall semester. Since the ME program's inception, there has been a 149% increase in the number of students. This program and others need significant laboratory space to support the curriculum. Multiple programs are currently leasing research space in downtown Pensacola.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

University Students, Faculty and Staff: 14,000+ students, 1,000+ faculty/staff.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Currently UWF is leasing research space in downtown Pensacola. When constructed, the building addition will allow for labs currently housed in remote off campus leased facilities to be brought back to campus. The project will provide expanded research space and contribute directly to the overall enhanced educational experience for students.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to meet deliverables will result in a return of funds to administering agency.
