14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The goal of the funds requested is to provide a state of the art career technical center that will provide an opportunity for career enhancement job placement for Brevard County residents and surrounding counties.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The services will provide a place and the means to hold various career and technical education programs, including automotive/diesel mechanics, intro to health care, construction, technology, and advanced manufacturing.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The services to be provided are career certificate programs in the area of technology, health care, construction and advanced manufacturing. Specifically, the initial focus will be in the areas of advanced manufacturing including CDL and automotive/diesel mechanic training. Other certifications will be offered based on local workforce and supply chain.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

We will serve our adult learner population within BACE and our surrounding community, targeting the population of jobless, economically disadvantaged, at-risk youth, homeless, developmentally disabled, physically disabled, and currently and formerly incarcerated persons. We expect to serve over 200 Brevard County residents with these career certificate programs.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

There is currently a labor need of approximately 41,272 annual job openings for technology, construction and advanced manufacturing. Specifically, there are over 21,000 annual job openings in CDL and automotive/diesel mechanics. The goal of the proposed program is to serve over 200 students per year. BACE will track data by tracking certification completers, surveying completers, and analyzing data from the regional occupation demand lists.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

BACE will return unspent funds to the state.
