14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of the requested funds is to offer the Civil Engineering curriculum and provide space for new students. The end- goal is to offer an ABET-accredited Bachelor's degree program in Civil Engineering at the campuses of the University of West Florida with an overall 5-year enrollment target at 200 students per year and a 5-year graduation target at 50 students per year.



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b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The activities will include: (1) development of an ABET-accredited Civil Engineering curriculum, (2) offering of an ABET-accredited Civil Engineering curriculum, and (3) purchase of necessary equipment and supplies for Civil Engineering labs. A part of the curriculum development, the concentrations for ABET accreditation will be planned and integrated into the curriculum, and shared resources with other Engineering disciplines and physics will be determined.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

A Bachelor's degree pathway in Civil Engineering will be provided to citizens in the northwest Florida region and beyond.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population for the Civil Engineering program are high school graduates and adult learners in the northwest Florida region. The 5-year plan is to build to 200 students participating in the Civil Engineering program per year.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit of this project is the establishment of a Civil Engineering program that will become a talent pipeline for companies in northwest Florida who have articulated a need for Civil Engineers. The methodology by which this outcome will be measured is the enrollment numbers and the number of Civil Engineer graduates each year.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to meet deliverables will result in a return of funds to administering agency.
