14. Program Performance



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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The purpose of the funding is to complete capital improvements to The Arc Gateway Pearl Nelson Center so that children with developmental delays or disabilities receiving therapies and early intervention services can utilize an efficient facility that meets all of their unique needs.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Renovations and improvements to the building and property including windows, HVAC, paint, flooring, interior structural changes, plumbing upgrades, security and fire systems, bathroom upgrades, electrical upgrades, lighting, new roof, parking lot, etc.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This facility will continue to house children's therapy and early intervention services provided to residents of both Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties. Last year, 976 unique children received services from The Arc Gateway Pearl Nelson Center.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The targeted population is children with identified developmental delays and/or disability diagnoses. We intend to serve as many children as possible and will meet last year's milestone of 900 children. Family members and other caregivers of these children receive indirect benefit of services as well.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Research shows that the 80% of brain development occurs by the age of 2. Therefore, identifying those children who would benefit from therapy and intervention is vitally important to their future success. Research also indicates that for every \$1 invested in these critical services, up to \$17 in savings can be realized in the reduced need for special education, healthcare services and reduction in abuse and neglect cases. The Arc Gateway Pearl Nelson Center measures progress towards goals in physical, mental, emotional and social development. Preparing children for kindergarten and equipping them with the tools necessary is at the forefront of daily activities. Providing these services in a facility which can meet the unique needs of these children is paramount to their success.
