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Design, construction, and inspection services for replacing the roof and chiller units of the Sheriff Administration Building will aid in preserving critical data collected to be used in judicial proceedings.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This work will enhance the building so that collected data for investigations are better protected during natural disasters, heavy rainfall, etc.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Citizens and visitors of Escambia County; during a sheriff investigation, thousands of samples are collected, processed and analyzed to ensure the data is handled correctly and properly processed in an effort to preserve evidence in a criminal investigation.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit of this project is to provide a more secure building in which evidence for criminal investigations are stored. A measurement of success is preservation of evidence after a natural disaster.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The contract will have penalties for not performing services as agreed to in the contract scope of work. These penalties could include monetary penalties, negative evaluations for the firm, decreased likelihood of obtaining additional work in the future, or if severe enough, criminal prosecution.
