a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Replacing the roof will aid in preventing future damages by eliminating moisture infiltration through the roof and being resilient allows the County to continue services due to minimizing potential impacts related to natural disasters.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Design, construction and construction inspection services for roof replacement will be completed through this grant to ensure community services can continue following heavy rainfall events and natural disasters.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Citizen complaints received are processed through this service center. Replacing the roof will ensure a safer environment to conduct normal business operations before, during, and after a natural disaster.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Citizens and visitors of Escambia County; thousands of work order requests are processed through this operation center during normal business as well as before, during, and after a natural disaster.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The resiliency upgrades will ensure services are not interrupted due to natural disasters, heavy rainfall, etc. A measurement of success is how quickly services can be provided to citizens after a natural disaster.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

The contract will have penalties for not performing services as agreed to in the contract scope of work. These penalties could include monetary penalties, negative evaluations for the firm, decreased likelihood of obtaining additional work in the future, or if severe enough, criminal prosecution.
