14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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This capital project will improve the learning environment by providing for stable temperatures/humidity in the building for the more than 3000 students attending various STEM programs throughout the year. Fewer fluctuations in the building environment will produce a stable learning environment resulting in fewer distractions, an increase in the ability to concentrate and retain information.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

An increase in reliability of the National Flight Academy's mechanical systems will produce a positive impact to every student who attends a program. This includes every Flight Academy participant (~2,000 students annually) and Escambia County 5th graders (~1500 annually) who attend the Department of Defense STARBASE program which resides within the National Flight Academy building.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Improvements to the building HVAC and mechanical systems will improve the learning experience for program attendees.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population includes Escambia County 5th grade students (~1,500 annually) and National Flight Academy attendees (~2,000 annually).

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Fewer fluctuations in the building environment will produce a stable learning environment resulting in fewer distractions, an increase in the ability to concentrate and retain information.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?
