Nature trail creation within East Navarre Preserve. Phase 1 will include the construction of a trail loop, parking area at the trail head. The preserve is critical habitat for endangered species including the Red Cockaded Woodpecker and Reticulated Flatwoods Salamander. The Eastern Indigo Snake and Gopher Tortoise also live within the habitat. By creating a trail through the preserve will allow for wildlife viewing, passive hiking trails, nature exploration and education.
