Ensuring future sustainability of critical and essential drinking water distribution and transmission as well as wastewater collection infrastructure systems which provide for drinking water and sewer collection in the project area and throughout the City's drinking water and wastewater service area. stormwater, sidewalk, and roadway improvements are also included providing an holistic approach.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population to be served by the project are the residents who reside in the project area as well as residents and visitors to the City of Boca Raton and those residents in portions of unincorporated Palm Beach County served by the City of Boca Raton's Utility Services Department.

The expected benefit and outcome of the projects is sustainable and reliable drinking water transmission and distribution as well as wastewater collection infrastructure systems to provide critical and essential services to the City's customers. Outcome can be measured in improved levels of service as well a decreased system interruptions.
