### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This project will reduce the amount of water withdrawal from the Upper Floridan aquifer (UFA) and move to the Lower Floridan aquifer (LFA) which is considered to be a suitable alternative water supply.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Funds will cover the Phase V-a of this project which is the purchasing of emergency generator and associated equipment.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?



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By moving towards the LFA as a source of potable drinking water, the City would be limiting the amount of water being withdrawn from the UFA. This new source will decrease the negative impact on the Silver Springs by dramatically increasing the springs' water levels.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Target population would be City of Ocala's water service territory customers which is approximately 65,000 individuals.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The current well field is approximately 2 miles from Silver Springs which is considered to be a first magnitude springs. This well field is hydraulically connected while the new well field is unconnected hydraulically to Silver Springs.
