14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The construction of a solid waste transfer station that would provide a more efficient method for moving solid waste to the landfill by decreasing route lengths of smaller collection vehicles and allowing the use of larger, more efficient, transfer vehicles to haul the solid waste the remaining distance to the land fill.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

A consultant has already been selected and the project is under design. These funds will be applied directly to construction costs.



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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Decreased roadway congestion by decreasing the number of trips to the landfill by solid waste collection vehicles. This decrease in trips also reduces roadway wear and tear generated by the solid waste collection vehicles. Also, by using more efficient haul vehicles, green house emissions are reduced.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population would be a significant portion of Escambia County by helping to keep service costs low and reduce traffic impacts.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Monthly truck mileage reports should show reduction in overall distance traveled. Reduced energy usage by solid waste collection vehicles should be evident at refill station. Customer complaints for missed pickups should be less frequent.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?
