Since ARPA funding was a one-time investment, the City made a policy decision to invest it in projects with the greatest need and long-term impact. The City received \$1.9 million in ARPA funding which it invested in utility engineering and design for critically needed improvements. This project leverages that investment. The City received \$750,000 in CDBG-COVID funds for water line extensions, again leveraging the earlier ARPA investment.
