4. Project/Program Description

The Powerhouse Youth Project offers on-campus instruction to students assisting them with identifying their passion and purpose after high school. Powerhouse provides a robust supplemental curriculum that engages students and prepares them to take the next step in their personal career development. Powerhouse offers individual career assessment with each student through the DISC personality profile assessment for careers. Once the assessment is completed students gain access to interaction with leaders who are active in those career fields to determine next steps in their preparation. Powerhouse removes geographical and social barriers by offering active mentors a choice of HIGH-TECH connection via their mobile or laptop or HIGH TOUCH, which involves direct interaction with students on or off campus. Powerhouse calls this strategy, Pathway to Purpose as it provides the "WHY" to education for students. Powerhouse is informational, inspirational, and transformational.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

-Reduction of high school dropouts by providing a tangible pathway to success.

-Active career assessment for individual students with a clear path for next steps.

-Understanding of life skills and budgeting based on selected career path.

-Provide a mentor to each student based on selected career path for accountability and accessibility to achieve the desired career path.

-Reduction of students entering the criminal justice system by providing an alternative option for negative behavior.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

On-campus classroom experiences that engage students using creative interactive learning.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Powerhouse will provide career and personal development for all students who engage within the strategy. Adults will also be provided training on active mentorship and given active connections to students.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

All youth ages 14-24 At-risk students who are currently in night school or alternative school environments. 2,000 students

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

-Reduction of high school dropouts by creating a pathway to discover their career and steps to achieve it.

This can be measured through pre and post testing, interview of participants and direct responses from mentors engaging the student.

-Increase workforce development for the community. Each campus will host a career day for employers to connect with students after they have completed the experiences. Participation in career day and total hired will be a measuring device used on the effect and impact within the community.

-Reduction of students entering the juvenile justice system. 80% of individuals incarcerated today are HS dropouts. Powerhouse will reduce those entering the DJJ system by providing them the alternative of a healthy productive lifestyle in society. This can be measured by analysis of students completing the experiences, securing employment or career path after high school.

-Increase awareness of potential careers and job opportunities.

-Increase mental health
