a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Bates WWTP is the only wastewater plant in the city, the expansion will allow the City to manage more wastewater to support the needs of the City and the City of Umatilla, protect the environment, maintain compliance with state regulations, and support the city's projected 20 year population growth. It will also extend the expected life cycle of the Plant to 50 years.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The expansion of the wastewater plant will include the construction of a biological treatment train, aeration equipment, clarifier basin and the replacement of the finish filters. This along with other modifications will increase the treatment capacity of the wastewater plant. Engineering began March 2021 and completed April 2023. Construction commenced June 2023 and is scheduled to finish November 2024.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

It will increase reusable water for local citizens and reduce pollutants in released wastewater to levels that are not harmful to the environment. It will also provide opportunity for residents to transition their homes from a septic system to a sewage system ensuring compliance with Florida Department of Environmental Protection.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This City must upgrade the Plant to accommodate increased demand from the Cities of Eustis and Umatilla and support continued population growth and development over the next 20 years. The target population served by this expansion is estimated at 6,734 in the City of Eustis, and an estimated 1,000 in the City of Umatilla (this includes, residential, school, commercial, mobile home parks etc.).

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Provides an opportunity to transition homes off of septic systems onto central sewer systems that provide nutrient removal technology and advanced wastewater treatment and ensures compliance with the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. The expansion and upgrades will support growth up to 2,700 new residential homes within the city limits, support new commercial business and existing business growth which will bring new jobs to the city. The Plant's life cycle will be extended to 50 years. Measures will include homes converting from septic to sewer, development of new homes, business growth and subsequent creation of new jobs.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

If deliverables are not met, the City of Eustis will pay back appropriated funds.
