#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The deep bed sand filter is a critical component of the treatment process and provides several essential purposes, including the removal of suspended solids, turbidity reduction, and nutrient removal. The filter is over 25 years old and the valves, pumps, and other components within the filters have deteriorated and need to be replaced. This project is one part of the full \$80,000,000 plant upgrade the City is preparing to fund and is for the complete mechanical and electrical rehabilitation.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Construction activities associated with the rehabilitation of the filter, along with engineering and inspection services to insure the project is constructed in conformance with the design documents.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Maintaining the Water Reclamation Facility will help provide our citizens with uninterrupted wastewater treatment with high level nutrient removal.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the sewer customers from the City of Port Orange, Town of Ponce Inlet, and City of Daytona Beach Shores; approximately 70,000 residents and businesses.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The benefit is expected to be high level nutrient removal through the deep bed sand filter. The measurements for nitrogen and phosphorus are collected downstream of the filter at the waste water treatment plant.
