a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Hardening of wastewater infrastructure to provide needed resiliency for maintaining service levels during and after storm events, and protect health and safety of the residents.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Rehabilitation of the lift stations with service life of 25 years and older to include structural improvements, pump repalcements, piping modifications, and manhole retrofits.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Recover from storm events with minimal health and safety concerns and threats to life and property. Prevent loss of service and/or use of sanitary facilities during and post-storm events.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Areas served by the wastewater lift stations. A total of 4,130 households; +/- 770 business establishments; 5 elementary and 1 middle school; 5 parks, 2 government facilities; and 2 places of worship.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Increased service life of exiting infrastructure, and reliability of equipment to efficiently operate to collect and transmit wastewater and maintain the levels of service. Maintain operational status during and after storm events. Minimize costs for damage resulting from flooded systems and other related causes.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to utilize the funds in the specified manor shall result in funds being returned to the State.
