a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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Dedicated Nursing Educational Training Unit for clinical rotations at the local Florida Veterans skilled nursing facility. To Fulfill directive in 2023 HB139 (Veteran benefits training/employment) and SB 274. Develop 3 bridge pathways for military veterans: 1) 68F PT Specialist (Army), Physical Medicine Apprentice (Air Force), PT Technician (Navy) to A.S. PTA with ability to become a licensed PTA 2) HM- Hospital Corpsman Basic (Navy) to PN3) HM- Hospital Corpsman Basic (Navy) to A.S. Nursing.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

3 new educational pathways are being created for veterans to utilize their skills gained in the military to transition as a licensed professional in the civilian workforce. Dedicated educational units on campus and at the Fla Veterans skilled Nursing Facilities will provide consistent clinical educational experiences. Fulfill directive in 2023 HB139 (Veteran benefits training/employment) and SB274.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Development of Dedicated Educational Training Units, Development of three bridge pathways for military veterans to include clinical experience: 1) 68F PT Specialist (Army), Physical Medicine Apprentice (Air Force), Physical Therapy Technician (Navy) to A.S. PT Assistant with ability to become licensed PTA 2) HM- Hospital Corpsman Basic (Navy) to Practical Nursing 3) HM- Hospital Corpsman.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population to be served by this project are the veterans transferring into the civilian workforce. 51-100 individuals are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit or outcome of this project is to improve mental health through licensure pass rates as well as job placement rates. The methodology by which this outcome will be measured is through providing reliable measures to demonstrate the ability of the veteran to successfully transfer into the civilian workplace in a respected profession. The ability to join a respected profession will have positive implications on the mental health of the veteran.
