Senior Center facility completion will allow us to provide congregate dinning and enrichment activities. Some programming and services would include health & wellness programs, home delivered meals, social activities, nutritional services, outreach programs, community engagement.

Senior Center facility completion will enhance health & wellness programs, home delivered meals, social activities, nutritional services, outreach programs, community engagement, safety enhancements, and sustainability initiatives in this area.

Congregate dining, home delivered meals, enhance health & wellness programs, social activities, nutritional services, outreach programs, Community engagement, and safety enhancements.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population are the aging seniors of Pasco County. Anyone over the age of 60, that qualifies for services in the Dade City area could benefit from this project. This includes elderly citizens; persons with poor mental health; persons with poor physical health. We expect to serve more than 800 citizens annually via services at this location.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

Completing this new facility will allow for the introduction of regular health and wellness programs, mindfulness meditation sessions, and nutritional meals, all of which can significantly improve physical and mental health among seniors, reducing stress and enhancing overall well-being in the modernized senior center. Measure: We can measure physical and mental health improvement through pre- and post-program surveys assessing stress levels, mood, and overall mental well-being, alongside tracking participation and feedback from seniors.

Failure to meet deliverables could result in reduced funding for future projects. This serves as a long-term consequence of non-performance, encouraging Pasco County Senior Services to prioritize meeting its obligations to the aging population of Pasco County.
