a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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To connect to an ever-growing community of veterans and their families, through a weekend of camaraderie and deepsea fishing. Since most Veterans claim to miss the bond of brotherhood that serving in the armed forces forges, Hookin' Veterans goal is to help them reconnect with other service members and re-establish this bond in an effort to combat the increase of veteran suicide.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

A four day all expense paid fishing excursion. Our goal is, and has been, to partner with other non-profits to expand our wellness, mental health and resiliency. We offer educational opportunities for the veteran to return home with knowledge regarding mental health resources and the skills to fish fresh water or salt water.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Disabled Veterans of the United States Armed Forces will be able to build community and camaraderie and these bonds help to combat mental health issues that have led to veteran suicide. This will take place through fishing excursions in which attendees gain skills and share experiences.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Disabled Veterans of the United States Armed Forces; 90 plus Veterans are expected to be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The expected benefit is to have Heroes remembered and Heroes honored. Allowing the Veteran(s) the kindle new bonds with brothers in arms and giving them an experience they will remember forever. This will be measured by questionnaires, surveys, and up-kept communication with attendees.
