The DoD SkillBridge program provides the opportunity for service members who are nearing the end of their military career the chance to gain civilian work experience and a path to a new career through training, apprenticeships, fellowships or internships.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

For the employer (industry partner), this program offers access to highly trained professionals at no cost, due to the fact that the service member is receiving military compensation and benefits.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project will serve approximately 100 service members nearing the end of their military careers and many more children served by Child Protective Investigators.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Give military members the chance to gain civilian work experience and a path to a new career through training, apprenticeships, fellowships or internships. Over the course of this pilot program, an average of 80% of SkillBridge participants are likely to be offered a permanent position after completion of the program. Additionally, this will increase the number of Child Protective Investigators within DCF. Outcomes will be measured by quantifying the number of Military Service Members connected with job opportunities upon re-entry to civilian life, as well as the number of children served by Child Protective investigators.
