The construction of North Independence Lane will spur redevelopment on the adjacent land parcels. The location is within the city's Downtown Development District and within one block of the city's SunRail regional rail station, bus stop, grocery store, post office, library, senior center, municipal offices and a city park. Likely redevelopment will attract mixeduse construction incorporating first-floor commercial/retail uses as well as high-density residential uses to create a live/work community that relies less on vehicle transportation and more on walking, cycling and public transit. Additionally, the new roadway will provide a safer route for pedestrians as opposed to the busy U.S. Highway 17/92 or Maitland



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c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The construction of this new roadway will provide enhanced and safe vehicular and pedestrian movement within the city's downtown core. This will include the roadway and public parking, including required accessible parking and accessible sidewalks.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target is the general public visiting, living and working in the downtown area.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

It will provide enhanced and safe vehicular and pedestrian movement within the city's downtown core and can be measured by the ADT of the road and the number of citizens that use the sidewalks and parking spaces.
