a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The Municipal Complex will include a modern City Hall building that serves as the administrative heart of the city/town. City Hall will house offices for the mayor, city council, administrative staff, and various city departments, providing a one-stop location for citizens to access government services, attend public meetings, and engage with their elected officials. A dedicated facility for the Police Department will be incorporated into the complex, providing a state-of-the-art police headquarters. This facility will include offices for police personnel, evidence storage, holding cells, interrogation rooms, training facilities, and modern dispatch and communication centers to support efficient law enforcement operations and enhance public safety. The Municipal Complex will also accommodate the Public Works Department, offering workspace for maintenance crews, equipment storage, vehicle maintenance facilities, and administrative offices.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Centralize essential government functions to enhance efficiency and accessibility.

- Provide a modern, secure headquarters for the Police Department to improve public safety.
- Facilitate effective public works operations and emergency response.
- Foster civic engagement through community meeting spaces.
- Promote sustainability and reduce long-term operating costs.
- Ensure inclusivity and accessibility for all residents.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Versatile community meeting spaces will be available for public use, civic engagement events, city council meetings, and community organization gatherings, promoting active involvement in local governance.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

City of Belle Isle with a population of over 7,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

- Improved service delivery and convenience for residents.
- Enhanced public safety through a dedicated police headquarters.
- Efficient public works operations and infrastructure maintenance.
- Increased civic engagement opportunities for the community.
- Demonstrated commitment to sustainability and inclusivity.
- Strengthened municipal infrastructure and long-term planning.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Penalty clauses for missing milestones or not maintaining adequate progress, thus endangering performance of the contract; penalties might include reduction and/or loss of State appropriation including liquidated damages of a predetermined sum to be paid to the City.
