To construct an interdisciplinary facility that addresses UCF's need for teaching laboratories and active learning classrooms across multiple colleges. This 100,000 gsf building will support UCF's space deficit in these categories and contribute to the achievement of the student success metrics outlined in UCF's Strategic Plan.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Planning, design, construction and equipping the Discovery & Innovation Hub.

Teaching and research activities for students in the Colleges of Sciences, Medicine, Engineering & Computer Science, and the Burnett School of Biomedical Sciences.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Teaching and research activities for students in the Colleges of Sciences, Medicine, Engineering & Computer Science, and the Burnett School of Biomedical Sciences.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

University and college students, including programmed activities for K-12 students; industries in the region in partnership relationships with UCF and employing UCF graduates.

More than 10,000 students per year will be served by the facility

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Benefit: New construction of state-of-the-art classrooms and labs for teaching and research activities; increase classroom and lab availability; facilities to engage in productive industry partnerships; Measure: Increasing STEM enrollment and graduates to increase the available talent pipeline and highly skilled workforce needed by Florida high-tech employers.

Benefit: Increasing the number of engineering, computer science and other high tech graduates translates to higher population level with elevated lifetime earning potential; Measure: Increasing Florida's tax base.

Benefit: Engineering and other high tech graduates are in high demand and will be immediately employed by Florida employers; Measure: A prepared, highly skilled, available workforce attracts industries and headquarters to locate to Florida and creates new native start ups.
