a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Funds will be used to construct and deliver the project.



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This project will reduce flooding and stormwater system overflows that inundate the rights of way, which negatively affects public health. During flood events this water pools in the rights of way instead of flowing through the undersized existing system, which increases the likelihood the public will come into contact with it. The proposed project will protect the public against flood and storm surge related hazards.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Complete reconstruction of NE 191st St, NE 29th Ave, and NE 188th St including raising the roadway elevation above flood levels, drainage system, catch basin, manholes, water quality treatment components, drainage outfall, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, landscaping, and street lighting.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This project will protect the general public from harm by improving the ability for emergency vehicles to use this roadway during increasingly severe rainfall events that flood the roadway completely.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

General population. City of Aventura is home to over 40,000 residents and receives well over 25 million visitors a year.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

This project will improve physical health, protect the public from environmental harm, improve transportation conditions, and increase economic activity by improving the roadways and infrastructure. The outcome will be measured by reduced number of and severity of flooding events and improved safety.
