a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Phase 2 of Pasco County Cultural Arts Project. Phase 2 will complete the acquisition and renovation of the new or existing property to expand and create additional cultural arts opportunities in Pasco County and the surrounding region. Surrounding cultural arts organizations will consult on renovation or construction of a new facility & future programming, to include concerts, performances, recitals, plays, school programs, and host local graduations, among others. After renovation/construction, and assuming an annual operating budget of \$1.2 million, the cultural arts theater and performing arts center is projected to have an annual economic impact to the city of \$5 million, including about \$110k in local tax revenue and state tax revenue of about \$168k.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

It will provide a facility to learn about and experience cultural arts, provide school programming, and educational opportunities to students, families, and the wider community and specifically, more underserved communities of the Tampa Bay Area.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

It will provide a facility to learn about and experience cultural arts, provide school programming, and educational opportunities to students, families, and the wider community and specifically, more underserved communities of the Tampa Bay Area.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The students, families, and citizens of Pasco, Hernando, Citrus, Polk, Hillsborough, and Sumter counties. The City of Zephyrhills is now the largest city in the county at more than 17,000 residents.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

After completion and assuming an annual operating budget of \$1.2 million, the theatre is projected to have an annual economic impact to the city of \$2,990,187, including \$108,086 in local tax revenue and state tax revenue of \$167,524. Measured by the Americans for the Arts Economic Prosperity Calculator.
