Palm Beach County is the recipient of CARES US Treasury funds in the amount of \$261 million. Funding was spent entirely on emergency assistance, mortgage assistance, business grants, COVID-19 sheltering, testing and isolation, as well as on emergency personnel. Palm Beach County also received approximately \$290 million in American Rescue Plan Funding for pandemic-related service and infrastructure projects.

14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Research shows older adults who participate in senior center programs can delay the onset of diseases and experience improvements in physical, social, emotional, and mental well-being. Studies have shown that creative activities can slow down memory disorder development and the onset of conditions such as Dementia and Alzheimer's. Making and even viewing art causes the brain to continue to adapt, restructure, and reshape, this leads to an increase in the potential to increase brain capacity. Moving the body through recreational activities is important for mobility and maintaining good physical health as one ages. These programs will improve the mind, body, and spirit of the seniors at our centers.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Arts activities with instructors such as pottery, crochet, sewing, and knitting. Other activities are Cardio Drumming, and Tai Chi which is a great form of exercise that can easily be adjusted for different fitness levels and assist with balance. We are also seeking to install walking paths on senior centers grounds for Walking Clubs and start-up of Gardening Clubs.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Skilled instructors to deliver programs. Each program offered through the grant funding, will have a physical, emotional or mental well-being benefit. Each program will outline specific benefits of that program with expected outcomes. Pre and post surveys and observations by staff will be conducted throughout the program to ensure the program is on track to meet expected outcomes.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Seniors and veterans in Palm Beach County. Over one thousand individuals will be served.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

We expect to see improved physical health, mental health, and improved education of seniors enjoying these programs. Participants will do pre and post surveys and assessments to determine improvements in these areas.
