a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Students will develop critical skills & foundational knowledge in the areas of Science, Technology, Engineering, & Mathematics. Students will dive into: simulations of anatomy & 3-D anatomical creations that can be produced via a 3-D printer, engineering concepts of real-world buildings, bridges, roads, & electric vehicles. Students will learn non-traditional ways to measure, calculate and design in accordance with STEM-related curricula.

Dream Big academy of Learning will provide Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematical lessons, labs, collaborative activities, and actual simulations to disadvantaged students in grades 3 -12.

Dream Big academy of Learning will provide Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematical lessons, labs, collaborative activities, and actual simulations to disadvantaged students in grades 3 -5.

Target Population expected to be served is 100-200 students. These students are primarily at-risk grade school students.

Project will open the gateway to a different type of learning from the traditional Math, Science, and Technology classes taught, thereby getting students interested in STEM related occupations, increasing the number of disadvantaged students accepting STEM related jobs in the future.
