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The funds will address a project in the East Auburndale community of the city which experiences significant flooding during king-tides, rain events, and effects of the sea-level rise. These funds will be used for new and up-sized stormwater inlets and pipes, ex-filtration trenches. It is estimated that 125 properties, 375 residents, valued at \$70M, will be impacted by this project.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

These funds will be used for right-of-way improvements including new and upsized stormwater inlets and pipes and new exfiltration trenches.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

Target population is a mix of mid to low income housing.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population are the residents of the City of Miami community of Auburndale. The Auburndale community consist of approximately 36,000 residents

- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
- 1. Improve physical health: Comparing number of flooding complaints before and after project
- 2. Enhance/préserve/improve environmental or fish and wildlife quality: Comparing number of cleaning sweeps by stormwater operations crews on the improved stormwater control structures (Pre & post construction) as well as physical observation of water being retained in structures or swales for longer periods before running off into adjacent waterways... 3. Improve transportation conditions: Comparing number of traffic accidents of affected roadways and from observation of better traffic flows due to reduced flooding in travel ways.
- 4. Improve surface water quality: Physical observation of water retained in structures or swale for longer periods before running off into adjacent waterways
- f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to meet deliverables or performance measures should subject the City to an audit and depending on the results of the audit the City could be liable for sanctions up to revocation of funding.
