The project purpose is to replace aged sand filters with cloth disk filters at the City's Wastewater Treatment Facility. Goals are to meet or exceed the Florida Department of Environmental Protection's standards for drinking water and restore confidence from the City's residents regarding the quality of the City's potable water supply and reduce system maintenance.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Replace the existing sand filters at the wastewater treatment facility with cloth disk filters will allow for increased capacity and less maintenance/downtime.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The City will be able to process and distribute high quality potable water that meets or exceeds all regulatory standards for safe, stable and reliable drinking water.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population if the general population of the City of Homestead, which is approximately 80,000 residents.
