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These funds will be used to complete the wastewater upgrades previously authorized by the Florida Legislature and to begin environmental restoration projects on the island including shoreline stabilization and erosion control. Upgraded wastewater and facilities will allow for greater access to the island and environmental sustainability projects will help ensure the island is available to be visited by residents and visitors for years to come.

Upgraded wastewater system will allow more visitors to experience the island and its historic/environmental resources. Sustainability projects including shoreline stabilization will help ensure the island and its shoreline are better protected from future storms.
