CARES Act: \$105M for Public Safety Needs & Economic Support; \$20.4M for Transit, Housing, Fire Rescue, Valkaria Airport, & Sheriff's Community Programs: \$32.6M for Emergency Rental Assistance; \$6.6M for HUD Programs, \$4.2M for Housing Programs; \$3M for Transit.
