#### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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The objective of these funds is to support the development and implementation of an Associate in Science Degree and College Credit Certificate in Financial Technology (FinTech). These funds will enable us to acquire classroom resources and technology that will support a high-quality educational experience; upgrade facilities; provide scholarships to financially disadvantaged students and recruit experienced faculty who can support and facilitate the program.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Curriculum development and equipment to allow citizens to pursue a degree or certificate in FinTech, the development of learning communities to ensure student success and degree attainment, providing college level instruction that will allow students to earn their degree or certificate and yield them employment opportunities upon graduation.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

We will provide academic support services directly to citizens/students such as program advising, career advising and internship opportunities along with a modern program to meet employer growth. In addition, we will work directly with middle school and high school students to provide supplemental education that will prepare them to seek a FinTech degree after graduation.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Veterans, jobless persons, economically disadvantaged persons, at risk youth, homeless, grade school students, high school students, university/college students.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Expected benefits and outcomes are improved quality of education, increasing and improving economic activity, and enhancing student economic self sufficiency. Outcomes will be measured through HCC's enterprise resource system and will track performance data for each student including: (1) certifications, degrees or licenses earned, (2) career placement, (3) rate of transfer to advanced education or training.
