14. Program Performance



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a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

In Summer 2024, the Boys & Girls Club of Martin County will open its flagship, 38,000 square foot club on the campus of Stuart Middle School. The funds requested will enable the installation of the IGNITE Manufacturing System powered by Amatrol in the club's state of the art workforce development labs, providing advanced manufacturing skills training & certification for a minimum of 250 workforce-ready teens & adults in year 1 & a minimum of 100 program graduates yearly in subsequent years.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

The Center will develop youth for college or career pathways starting in 8th grade and even earlier. High school graduation will be positioned as a launch pad, rather than a destination. Students attending Stuart Middle and others in the community, will have access to the Labs, as appropriate, during the school day to engage in career exploration.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

IGNITE provides multi-dimensional hands on and eLearning courses that lead to certification in some of industry's highest-demand professions. It consists of 6+ courses with all required trainers, eLearning curriculum, instructor's guides and training, delivery and installation. All courses will be offered at no charge to citizens.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The majority of the funds requested will serve jobless persons, economically disadvantaged persons, middle and high school students, university/college students. The project will serve a minimum of 250 individuals in year one and at least 100 individuals in subsequent years.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

75% of the students who enroll in the IGNITE Program will gain technical and employability skills that will lead to certification in Advanced Manufacturing, Introduction to Systems, Mechatronic Systems, Digital Manufacturing Systems, Advanced Materials & Design, IIoT, Data Analytics, & Networking and Industrial Maintenance. All participants will be registered and entered into an online database. Progress and results will be tracked, and the data will be analyzed and reported by an independent, 3rd party evaluator. Participants will also participate in pre-and post-surveys to assess program efficacy.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to meet deliverables would result in financial consequences including withholding of funding or reduction in specified payments.
