a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

This funding will assist approximately 170 property owners in the Biscayne Shores neighborhood to abandon septic tank systems and connect to the sanitary sewer system. This project will provide an incentive for timely connection to the system.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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The septic systems will be disabled according to state requirements and plumbing connections will be made from the houses to the public sewer infrastructure. All associated permits will be obtained.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The property owners will receive services to abandon their existing septic tank systems and establish the plumbing to connect the home to the sanitary sewer system. Assistance will also be provided for obtaining necessary permits.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

Approximately 170 property owners in the Biscayne Shores neighborhood.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Reduce potential exposure to wastewater from compromised and failing septic tank systems that are vulnerable to high groundwater and the redirection of wastewater discharge to the environment from septic tank systems to the sanitary sewer system. This will remove nutrient and bacterial sources of pollution from septic tank effluent. These outcomes will be measure by the number of septic tank systems removed and pounds per day of nutrient reduction per septic tank system removed.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to meet deliverables will result in nonpayment.
