4. Project/Program Description

The Town of Davie is seeking to make improvements at Waterford Park. The five-acre facility with an array of community amenities. Through observation, environmental testing, and survey, an aspect of the park was identified as being in substantial disrepair. Based on the unsafe condition of the hockey rink and tennis courts, the Town closed these amenities. The funds will be used to excavate the unsuitable soil, replace the area with fill, ADA compliant sidewalks, and new LED lights.

The money was used for a combination of expenses such as mortgage foreclosure and rental eviction programs, Emergency Order compliance enforcement, PPE Expenses, Cleaning/Disinfection, Public Information, Public Safety Payroll, Facilitate Compliance, Residential Assistance, Small Business Assistance, and Community Programming. The Town also received \$17 million in American Rescue Plan Act funds.

There will be improvements made to the Town of Davie's park which will provide the community access to using these amenities at their leisure. The Town currently does not have pickleball courts in the western portions of Davie. The sport has grown to be very popular over the years. In addition, there will be ADA compliant sidewalks to assist those who want to access the facility.
