a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

The funds will be used to design, and install and efiltration system around the perimeter of the baseball field to improve drainage of the field and reduce the number of days the field cannot be used due to flooding. The baseball dugout and bull pen will be improved and the fence replaced.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?



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Installation of 12 inch perforated ex-filtration system at the perimeter of the park, resurface baseball field, incorporate

drainage system underneath resurfaced field.
c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

No direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the City of Miami community residing in Zip Code 33127. The park is expected to serve a community of approximately 28,000.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

Fewer injuries to park users that play baseball or softball and more days the field will be available for use because of reduced flooding. These outcomes can be measured by comparing the number of injuries occurring on the baseball field, and the number of days the field was closed due to flooding before and after the repairs are made.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

Failure to meet deliverables or performance measures should subject the City to an audit and depending on the results of the audit the City could be liable for sanctions up to revocation of funding.
