### 14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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CCUA's expansion of the Keystone Heights Water WRF will provide infrastructure to support development in and around the City of Keystone Heights in an environmentally sustainable way by evaluating technology to increase the level from a secondary treatment system to a more advanced treatment. The Keystone Heights WRF currently has a design treatment capacity of 70,000 Gallons Per Day (GPD). With evaluation and planning of upgrades, total WRF treatment capacity could reach 200,000 GPD.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Requested allocated funds would be used directly to assist in the evaluation, planning, and design of WRF expansion and upgrades.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The WRF facility upgrades will protect the environment and improve water quality by providing a higher level of treatment than the existing facility. Expanding the facility treatment capacity will support future conversions of residents from septic systems, directly improving nutrient impacts to surrounding water resources. An expanded WRF will also provide water reclamation services to support future areas of residential and commercial development in and around the Keystone Heights area.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The area in and around Keystone Heights has a population of roughly 15,000 people. The existing WRF serves 118 commercial and residential accounts equally 267 Equivalent Residential Connections (ERC). Expanding the WRF will serve roughly 1,000 ERCs resulting 733 additional homes connected to CCUA's centralized sewer system.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?

The WRF facility upgrades will provide a more advanced level of treatment of domestic wastewater to meet or exceed current regulatory standards. In addition, CCUA will be able to serve more homes currently supported by septic tanks. CCUA more advanced treatment levels and reduction in the homes with septic tanks will reduce nutrient loads being released to the environment.

CCUA will measure outcomes for this project by the nutrients removed during the treatment process (BOD, TSS, N, P) in accordance with the facility FDEP permit. CCUA will also identify the number of homes and businesses connected to the system annually.

f. What are the suggested penalties that the contracting agency may consider in addition to its standard penalties for failing to meet deliverables or performance measures provided for the contract?

CCUA will work with the FDEP to provide contractual safeguards for performance of the work outlined in this request.
