4. Project/Program Description

This project's purpose is to construct a new +/- 6,000 SF building consisting of adequate office space for personnel, a conference room, break room and record storage area. The current Sheriff's Department is housed in +/- 2,800 SF of the Dixie County Courthouse, which can be disruptive during the busy hours. The Sheriff's Department has outgrown the current space, and it is not large enough to hold necessary meetings during states of emergencies. Before/during/after Idalia, the Sheriff had no private place to meet with all of the outside agency personnel that came to assist the county during this catastrophic event. This caused issues with meeting and coordinating efforts during this declared emergency. The new building will double the square footage, be dedicated only to the Sheriff's Department, provide room for expansion, and include paved spaces and grassed-overflow parking. The new buildings will also provide space for outside emergency personnel to convene.

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14. Program Performance

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Construction of a new +/- 6,000 square foot building that will provide sufficient office space to accommodate current staff, as well as future expansion. Additionally, it will provide adequate meeting space, adequate parking and improve public access. The current administrative building is 2,800 SF, which is not large enough to hold emergency services during declared emergencies or disasters. The project will double the square footage for the new building, and include 30 paved spaces for parking and a grassed parking for additional overflow parking.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Planning, design, permitting, engineering, and construction services will all be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The new building will double the square footage, be dedicated only to the Sheriff's Department, and include 30 paved parking spaces and a grassed parking for additional overflow parking. The design, permitting, and construction of the building will improve community safety. It will also provide space for outside emergency personnel, who are activated during disasters, to convene.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

The target population is the community of Dixie County and surrounding areas; Dixie County's population is +/- 17,000. The target population for the outside emergency personnel will vary depending on the length, severity and duration of the emergency situation. Additionally, it will benefit the other constitutional offices by providing the current office space used by the Sheriff's Office in the courthouse for their expansion.

e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will

be measured?

With the new building, the business of the Sheriff's Department will not interfere with the business of the Dixie County Courthouse, and vice versa. The Sheriff's Department employees and people served will no longer be crowded into a small space to perform the day-to-day duties. There will be larger office space to increase organization, provide conference and break rooms, allow for more staff, and thereby reduce workloads, which will collectively minimize stress for the employees. Outside emergency personnel will be better able to coordinate efforts with the Dixie County Sheriff's Department during a state of emergency. It will provide adequate space for records retention, providing a more streamlined service for public records requests. Further, relocating to a standalone facility will improve the public's access to the Sheriff's Office.
